Migrations of people are social phenomenon. They describe the physical movement of people from one to the other area, usually over large distances. Migrations have been present since prehistoric times, while throughout historic periods they occurred in the form of voluntary migrations, within one area or between several of them, or in the form of forced migrations. Migrations include various phenomena such as development of alphabets and literacy, different cultural influences and interactions and, on the other hand, phenomena such as human slavery, poverty, persecution, ethnic cleansing etc. One of the consequences of migrations, due to different historical, social, economic and cultural diversity they conveyed, was the birth of a new multicultural heritage. The reaction of individuals and communities to such movements of people can be very different. The migrations of all kinds had an enormous impact on human history and they significantly changed the macro-world as well as the micro-world. In contemporary world, which is characterized by the mobility and information flow, migrations became an integral part of life and society. Moreover, scope and patterns of migrations become more and more complex.

6. Keywords – not exceeding 5 words
